

**Title:** Bobby Chandler Education Internship

**Description:**

Bobby Chandler Interns lead tours of the Virginia Museum of History and Culture long-term exhibition, *The Story of Virginia*, conduct project-based activities in the Weinstein Learning Center, and assist the Educational Services staff with programs for audiences of all ages. Participants must be available in the Spring semester. Applicants must be over eighteen and must undergo a background check. The Bobby Chandler Internship program is generously supported by the Kip Kephart Foundation.

**Duration of Internship Program:**

- One Semester (Spring).
  - \$1,000 Stipend
  - Eligible for academic credit

**Required Days/Hours per week:**

- Minimum 2 days a week, morning availability strongly preferred.
- Between 10-15 hours a week.
- Occasional weekend/evening work may be required.

**Applicant Qualifications:**

**Required:**

- Willingness to work with students/children.
- Ability to address audiences for 60-90 minutes.
- Ability to apply age-appropriate interpretive techniques.
- Understanding of basic technology.

**Preferred:**

- Experience working with students/children.
- Experience interpreting content for visitors in a museum exhibition.
- Experience using primary sources in research.

**Physical abilities required:**

- Ability to lift 15 pounds
- Ability to stand/walk for 90 minutes

**GPA Requirement:**

- Minimum 3.0 GPA

**Application requirements:**

- Resume
- Cover Letter
- Recommendation from professor
- Completed online application

**Application deadline:** accepted on a rolling basis, deadline Dec. 7th, 2018
